BOARDING RULES

1. We do ask that you worm your horse at least once every three months.
2. All horses' feet must be trimmed or shod every eight to nine weeks or we will have it done and bill you.
3. We highly recommend that all horses get a four way shot once every year.
4. Each stall horse is required to have a halter and good solid lead rope.
5. Stall horses should have their own grain bucket with their name on it.
6. We do ask that each horse owner visit their horse often and consult with us on any concerns or questions.
7. Office hours are 10am to 5pm daily. If you plan on visiting or riding after hours please let the office know. The gate to the barn will be locked each night.
8. We ask that all boarding fees be paid on the due date. Any board which is 10 days late will be considered over due and a \$20.00 late fee will be charged. Any board which is 15 days late will be given a removal notice unless prior arrangements have been made. We do ask for 30 days notice if you plan to remove your horse per your boarding agreement.
9. Horse trailers may be left on the ranch at your own risk of damage. They must be kept clean and not become an eye sore.
10. Any tack or personal items left at the stables are at your own risk.
11. Boarders may use the Tie rail in front of the barn area to groom or saddle.
12. To bath your horse please, use the hose at the Barn area. If in question ask.
13. We recommend that all riders use a two way radio in case of an accident.
14. We do not allow any horse to be in the main parking area at any time. All loading and unloading is to be done at the barn area.
15. Boarders are to use the trail behind the main corral for going to the beach or dune trails. At the hwy never stop traffic and if your horse is not good with traffic walk them across to the other side and re mount.
16. If you leave your saddle or other equipment at the stables, it is at your own risk.

17. We ask that at no time you feed or treat any horse other than your own. Please never grain your horse in the pasture. Bring the horse down to the barn area.
18. Never ride your horse in the pasture.
19. Always close gates behind you for the horses' safety.
